





- 1. Place cabinet (you are attaching bracket to) next to the work surface. Fig. 1
- Center Bracket on cabinet (do not include the door/drawer front in your measurement). Fig. 2
- 3. Tape Work Surface Supporting Bracket to cabinet in desired location.
- 4. Determine and mark bracket holes based on which cabinet it is on. Fig. 3
- 5. Remove any drawers in cabinet near the bracket.
- 6. Remove bracket and tape, drill pilot holes with 1/8" drill bit. Wear protective eyewear.
- 7. Using the 1/8" holes as guides, finish drilling holes with 13/32" drill bit.
- 8. Insert the supplied bolts through the bracket into the holes in the side panel. Secure the bolts on the inside of the cabinet using the flat washers and nuts. Fig. 4
- 9. Align work surface to cabinet and bracket. Put pressure on top of work surface and attach using 4 work surface screws. Fig. 5
