
LOCKER GANGING INSTRUCTIONS

(single, double, quad and cubbie lockers)

Side-by-Side Ganging


- 1. Open door and remove false floor(s) by pushing down on the back of the floor in order to grab the front.
- 2. Align and level cabinets by adjusting leveling glides
- 3. Using an electric driver install the (4) #10 x 1/2" self drilling Phillips pan head screws through clearance/service holes on the side panels. Two service holes are located near the top and two near the bottom on

- each side as shown.
- 4. Insert the (4) cover plug caps on the top two service holes on each cabinet. The bottom service holes will be hidden by the false floor.
- 5. Replace false floor(s).



Back-to-Back Ganging

- 1. Open door and remove false floor(s) by pushing down on the back of the floor in order to grab the front
- 2. Align and level cabinets by adjusting leveling glides.
- 3. Drill 5/16" holes through back panel approximately 2" from top and 1/2" in from inside edges.
- 4. Insert 1/4" pan head screw through 5/16" holes and tighten using the provided washer and nut.
- 5. Replace false floors.





DO NOT pull downward on doors or drawers

DO Unload contents before moving unit or adjusting glides

DO Install against wall or gang to a similar unit

All single wide lockers need to be anchored or ganged together to meet BIFMA stability requirements.
